National AIDS Centre: Aims and Tasks

1. Running analysis and evaluation of the national epidemiological situation, planning and coordinating national and international HIV/AIDS clinical research
2. Experience exchange and cooperation in HIV/AIDS-related issues with other countries
3. Carrying out national HIV/AIDS and people living with HIV/AIDS care and treatment programmes
4. Creation, coordination and execution of the National HIV/AIDS Prevention and People Living with HIV/AIDS Care and Treatment Programme in coming years (in cooperation with selected government agencies)
5. Cooperation with regional authorities in carrying out national HIV/AIDS prevention strategies
6. Financing approved regional HIV/AIDS prevention projects
7. Creation and monitoring of modern treatment and diagnostic standards for health centres aiding people living with HIV/AIDS
8. Assessment and testing of latest HIV/AIDS diagnostic techniques and their introduction in specialist centres countrywide
9. Financing highly specialized HIV/AIDS diagnostics
10. Cooperation with international organizations dealing with HIV/AIDS, especially UNAIDS, WHO and UNDP.

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
