Gynaecological Care

Statutory aims

Outpatient Clinics :

- prenatal care of physiologic and pathologic pregnancy in the Outpatient Clinic for Pathologic Pregnancy, Obstetric & Gynecologic Outpatient Clinic, Outpatient Clinic for Pregnant Women with Heart Disease;
- gynecologic care for teenagers in Outpatient Clinic for Girls;
- diagnostics and treatment of hormonal disturbances in the Endocrinology Outpatient Clinic;
- diagnostics and treatment of infertility in the Outpatient Clinic of Infertility;
- perinatal care of HIV infected pregnant women in the Outpatient Clinic for HIV/AIDS patients;
- diagnostics and treatment of pathology of lower part of genital tract in the Outpatient Clinic of Colposcopy and Pathology of Uterine Cervix;
- gynecologic and obstetric ultrasonographic diagnostics; diagnostic procedures during pregnancy (amniocentesis, trophoblast's biopsy) in the Diagnostics Ward;
- perinatal care for pregnant women with fetal abnormalities in the Outpatient Clinic of Fetal Failures;
- complex and high-specialized radiological diagnostics in Magnetic Resonance Ward.

Inpatient Clinic's wards:

- Ward of Gynecology : complex diagnostics, non-surgery and surgery treatment of genital tract diseases;
- Ward of Perinatology : complex diagnostics and therapy of pathology of early pregnancy;
- Ward of Pathological Pregnancy : complex diagnostics and therapy of the pathology of pregnancy;
- Ward of Labor : physiologic, instrumental and surgical labors;
- Obstetrical Ward : post-delivery care;
- Ward of Neonatology : medical care for newborns, including complex and high-specialized care for pre-term newborns (Intensive Care Unit).

Neonatology Clinic:

- medical care of the newborn
- medical care of the children born prematurely

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
